Northern Star Community Challenge

Saturday 3 June 2023 – Individual/Relay Race over 132km

No Licence, No Race: An AusCycling licence is required for all Community Challenge riders (for insurance purposes). AusCycling offer a "Lifestyle" licence at a cost of \$7.00. Click [HERE](#) to purchase your licence. You will need to show proof of purchase of your licence at Registration

0700: Alliance Airlines flight departs Perth – Perth Airport Terminal 2

0815: Riders are met at Kalgoorlie airport and transported to the start of the race by bus

0700 to 0900: Registration and assembly of bikes at St Mary's Catholic Church, 24 Brookman Street, Kalgoorlie

- Each Rider is to collect their Goldfields Cyclassic rider number and transponder from the Registration desk. Proof of a current AusCycling licence must be shown at that time.
- Bike boxes and personal overnight bags to be left with Allied truck to be securely transported to Menzies. Please do not place bags on the GRT bus or with an official.
- Facilities available: bike mechanic, toilets.

00830: Rider briefing at St Mary's Catholic Church, 24 Brookman Street, Kalgoorlie. **Rider Briefing is compulsory for all riders**

0930: Northern Star Community Challenge riders (or fist team member) depart

- After watching the start of the ride, each support vehicle continues to the first changeover at Paddington. Support vehicles must go directly to the first changeover and not trail their or other riders on the road.
- At the changeover please pull completely off the road and wait for your first rider to arrive, hand over the timing chip to the second rider who will then set off for Davyhurst. Be aware of traffic using the road.

- The support vehicle can then move on to the changeover at Davyhurst. Please watch for other riders. The third rider will take the timing chip to Comet Vale where the final rider will take the chip and continue to Menzies.

1300 to 1530: Riders arrive in Menzies. Muffins and fruit will be available at the Registration desk located outside the Visitor Centre on Brown Street

Facilities available: Showers will be open adjacent to the Town Hall and at the Caravan Park. Please ensure you have a towel and everything you need to be comfortable after the race

The Allied truck will be located in the car park on the north side of Brown Street (opposite the registration desk). Bags are to be picked and bikes locked away from 1430. **Riders are responsible for packing their own bikes.** The truck will be locked at 1600

1600 – 1900: The Shire of Menzies Classic Dinner: The Menzies Hotel is the venue for post-race relaxation and progressive dinner for riders and supporters. Tickets for the dinner are available for purchase at Registration on Saturday 3 June.

1900: The Shire of Menzies Classic Awards in Menzies Town Hall

2030: Fireworks display thanks to the Shire of Menzies. Please note that the GRT Minesite Transfers buses will be leaving for Morapoi Station and Kalgoorlie after the awards dinner and fireworks display
